Accelerated Master's pathway update

- Recall: at November 2023 Council a proposed “accelerated” MSc pathway was discussed
 - Allows **excellent** UofG BComp students to complete some required MSc coursework during senior year of ugrad to enable a faster completion
 - OGPS proposed a framework that allows up to **1.0 credits to be waived** from their MSc requirements if completed as part of their ugrad degree requirements
- Solicited feedback after Nov Council meeting showed sufficient interest from faculty to pursue further
- Graduate Curriculum Committee also supports this pathway and are finalizing admission criteria and policies to bring to Council in April

Available Grad Fund to help Recruit Strong Students

- **SoCS Doctoral “Summer” Scholarship**
 - \$2,500 / year (Summer term only) for duration of guaranteed funding period
- **Graduate Tuition Scholarships (Domestic):**
 - Top-up funding (above base GRA) for incoming MSc or PhD in S24, F24, W25
 - 7 awards of \$4000 (one-time award)
- **Dean’s Entrance Scholarship**
 - \$5,000 (one-time award)
- **Competitive Matching Fundings (CMF)**
 - Competitive funding package to match (but not exceed) that from another University
 - Minimum first-class admission average 80% (A-)
- **International Doctoral Tuition Scholarship (IDTS)**
 - \$12,5000 / year for 4 years
 - Minimum first-class admission average 80% (A-), or after successful completion of QE

MCTI Updates

- F24 admissions update (deadline extended to Mar 1st)
 - We've received ~200 applications
 - Target is 60 incoming for F24
 - Aiming to make ~100 offers based on expected acceptances and possible deferrals
 - Current status:
 - 8 accepted offers from deferrals from W24
 - ~80 offers on new applications (accepted offers, pending offers, offers being prepared)
 - ~45 pending decision
- Discussing with Dean's office whether to extend deadline
 - Understandable anxiety around evolving international student situation and impact on accepted offers, etc.
- Mitacs MCTI projects: ~7 internships across 6 companies

Grad Admissions Update

- College is investigating an **in-house graduate admissions system** to replace the OUAC system
 - Financial reasons (application fee would be collected by College vs. OUAC)
 - More control over application process, including deferrals (common for international students; costly and time consuming)
 - Opportunity to access more data about who's applying to which programs, their qualifications, etc.
- College is also discussing with units offering course-based Master's programs to **centralized admissions process**, as many students apply to multiple programs – early discussions

MCLC (Master of Cybersecurity Leadership and Cyberpreneurship) Update

- Reminder:
 - Executive-level Master's joint program with LANG
 - 3 courses from SoCS, 4 courses from LANG
 - OR
 - 3 courses from SoCS, 3 courses from LANG, 1 project course
- Approved by Council in June 2022
- Reviewed by Board of Graduate Studies (BOGS)
 - Requested some program revisions, including new, full-remote professional, executive seminar (originally proposed to use existing MCTI seminar for this program)
- Program will be re-reviewed in March BOGS meeting
