## PLO Mapping Process

- A. Oct 6, 2020: SoCS council was briefed on PLO mapping.
- B. Oct 27: Admin team decided to map required courses.
- C. Nov - Dec 14:
  - 1. Undergrad Cur Cmt proposed PLOs for General degree.
  - 2. SoCS council approved PLOs for General degree.
  - 3. Teaching options and assessment options were compiled.
  - 4. Qualtrics survey was programmed.
- D. Nov 9-20: Program Imp Cmt discussed capstone PLO mapping.
- E. Dec 15: SoCS council was briefed on survey, which opened.
- F. Dec 15 to Jan 29, 2021:
  - 5. 22 faculty members mapped PLOs for 24 courses.
  - 6. Some faculty mapped 2 courses.
  - 7. Some courses are mapped multiple times.

## PLO Mapping Process

- G. Feb 2, 2021: Options for capstone mapping from Prog Imp Cmt was discussed at SoCS council (4250 for SENG; none for CS).
- H. Feb 23: 2<sup>nd</sup> PLO mapping of 4250 from capstone perspective
- I. Feb 3 - Mar 1: Surveys were compiled into user-friendly format and missing PLOs were identified.
- J. Mar 26: Cur Cmt amended PLO mapping:
  - 1. CS: Global Understd added to 2500, 2520, 2750, 3750 and 3760 (taught and assessed).
  - 2. General: Global Understd , Historic Dev, & Intercultural Comp added to 1050, 1300, 2170, 2500, 2520, 3530 (taught, but not assessed in some).
- K. Apr 27: SoCS council approved Cur Cmt proposal to delete Teamwork and Leadership from General PLOs.
