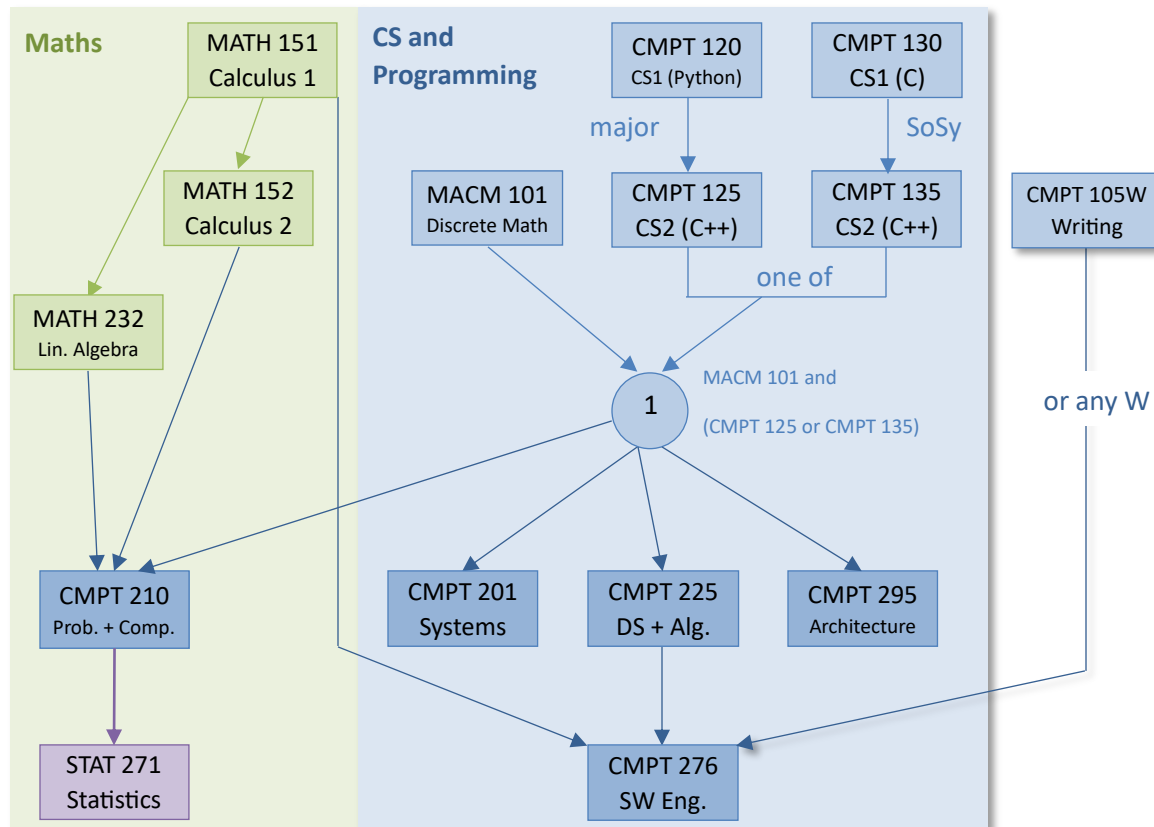

Notes

- Other majors' prerequisites not shown (ENSC, PHYS).
- There are other MATH courses equivalent to MATH 151, 152 and 232.
- CMPT 225 is a prerequisite for seventeen of the twenty-one 3rd year courses (not CMPT 308, 320, 340 and 376W).

WQB Requirements

Writing, Quantitative, Breadth (WQB) requirements are set at the level not at the departmental level. Students must complete 36 credits of WQB designated courses with a C- or greater grade.

- 1 lower-division W course (3 credits)
- 1 upper-division W course in the *student's major subject* (3 credits)
- 2 Q courses (6 credits) – these will be covered by CS student's MATH requirements
- 2 Breadth-Humanities courses (6 credits)
- 2 Breadth-Science courses (6 credits)

- 2 Breadth-Social Science courses (6 credits)
- 2 additional courses outside the student's major subject

Students must complete the WQB requirements to be granted a degree.
