Courses to Survey

- A. No. CIS courses: 47
- B. No. CIS courses required by the 3 programs: 24
 - Action: Each required course is mapped by 1 faculty.
- C. No. courses to be surveyed per faculty: 1 or 2
 - ☐ The <u>faculty member</u> who taught a course most often or most recently is assigned to map the course, subject to mapping work load balancing.
- D. Survey actions for a given course
 - ☐ If a course is required by all 3 programs, it needs to be mapped for each program.
 - ☐ Action: For each program that requires the course, indicate
 - 1. which PLOs are taught, and
 - 2. which PLOs are assessed.
