## Cyber Lab Setup and Marketing

- A. After 5 month effort by cyber faculty, IT staff, and CCS staff, consensus on cyber architecture is reached.

- B. Funding requested: 1<sup>st</sup> year: \$247K; Annual: \$108K;
- C. Tuition: Domestic target: \$25K; International: ?;

  - 1. Tuition may not appear attractive to fresh graduates.
