



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5. SUMMER SEMESTER

Curriculum Items Oct. 11, 2016

Co-op Plans and Things to Consider for This Semester

- -New Co-op schedule.
- -Delete ISHB
- -New 1500 for majors and other computing intensive students.
- -Consider moving the simulation and modelling course to third year.
- -Reorder semesters 3 and 4.
- -Consider if summer semester DE courses should be deleted.
- -Move 1910 and 2910 to semesters one and two respectively.
- -Consider low enrolment courses and lab lengths.

Benefits of a new Co-op Schedule include:

- Increasing the number of students we can accept into Co-op and overall.
- Creates additional offerings of courses.
- Splits several core courses and potentially reduces class sizes.
- Solves the existing problems with sequencing the CIS*3750 and CIS*3760 courses.

Motion: The School of Computer Science will replace the existing Co-op schedule with one which includes a summer academic semester. This is contingent upon the school receiving funding for the three new tenure track faculty members necessary to support the additional teaching requirements associated with this new schedule.

Enrollment for 16/17 calculated as a percentage of average incoming enrollments for 12/13 and 13/14 = 155. 4300 as a percentage of that is 45%. So estimate for 17/18 is taken from average of 13/14 + 14/15 = 213 * 0.45.
