# International Programs Committee

- Started in early 2014 after the first visit from DNU in Nov. 2013:
  - Major mandate: work on building a joint program in B.Comp (Computer Science)
  - Old members: Stefan Kremer, Bill Gardner, Greg Klotz,
     Zoe Zhu, and Fei Song
  - □ Current members: David Chiu, Xining Li, Fei Song
  - Strong desire to bring Greg Klotz and Zoe Zhu back to the committee.

## Joint Program with DNU in BComp(CS)

- □ The official agreement was signed in summer 2015 after two years' preparation and efforts
- The first student, Alex Zhu, came to Guelph in fall 2016.
- Several potential applicants, but only one passed the English test and made it here.
- □ Alex struggled with CIS\*2750 but overall adapted well to our program.

# Next Steps for the DNU Program

- Prepare a checklist with the timelines so that new applicants can have a smooth process
- Communicate with DNU about the current status:
  - How many possible applicants for fall 2017?
  - Any helps do they need and any ideas for promotion?
  - □ If the language requirement is a big issue, whether we can encourage them to explore the ESL program in Guelph?

## **Academic Exchanges**

- DNU wants to know if we are interested in sending visitors to each side:
  - Each side will cover the expenses for the visitors, including travel, accommodation, and meals.
  - More feasible at the DNU side since they usually have specially allocated funds and hotel/restaurant on campus.
