




4. INTERIM DIRECTOR'S REMARKS: Case for the Hiring of New Faculty

\square Significant erosion of instructional quality


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
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Number of FTE undergraduate students




Number of FTE faculty

Number of faculty we should hire to get the same student / faculty ratio as various universities








